Morning Care

Students will be supervised in a classroom until the first session of summer school begins.

Session 1: 8:30 to 10:00 a.m. Daily

Cost \$275

Introduction to Kindergarten – Part I (ELA and Math Skills)

This will be a time for your child to become familiar with the daily classroom routines and environment that they will encounter in Kindergarten! Students will be engaging in morning activities such as; calendar, morning work, counting, etc. Students will be actively participating in various Language Arts and Math lessons, as well as developmental activities that relate to the weekly themes!

K-1 Transition Reading

Join your friends from kindergarten as we cover reading for understanding and responding. We will read high frequency words and unpredictable words. Writing and test taking strategies will be introduced with a focus on spelling. This class is open to current kindergarten students who will be transitioning to first grade in the fall.

First Grade Reading

Come and review phonic and reading strategies. Students will strengthen their phonics and decoding skill and apply reading strategies that will improve reading comprehension and fluency through various interactive and engaging strategies. This class is open to current first grade students who will be transitioning to second grade in the fall.

Second Grade Reading

Join your friends this summer as we read your required summer reading book. We will complete the project that will be assigned with the summer reading. Together we will read a great book, practice our reading skills and strategies, play games with new vocabulary words, act out our favorite scenes, and illustrate important parts of the story. We will be incorporating technology into the classes and iPads are required. This class is open to current second grade students who will be transitioning to third grade in the fall.

Third Grade Reading

Join your friends and read your required summer reading book. We will complete the project that will be assigned with the summer reading. Students will practice reading

skills, play games with vocabulary, act out important scenes, and illustrate their favorite parts of the book. We will be incorporating technology into the classes and iPads are required. This class is open to current third grade students who will be transitioning to fourth grade in the fall.

Fourth Grade Reading

Join your fellow classmates this summer and complete your fifth grade reading assignment. Comprehension skills, grammar, writing skills, and creative expression will be incorporated into the interpretation of this historical fiction adventure. This class is open to current fourth grade students who will be transitioning to fifth grade in the fall.

Fifth Grade Math

If you love math or would like to strengthen your skills this summer, then we have the class for you! Join your friends in a fun-filled and educational math class. You can expect to participate in interactive activities and games, fun and challenging projects. You will also spend time strengthening your math skills on your iPad. This class is open to current fifth grade students who will be transitioning to sixth grade in the fall.

Sixth Grade Reading

Join your fellow classmates as you read your required summer reading. Students will also complete the seventh grade reading assignment that will be due in the fall. We will be focusing on reading comprehension, specific reading strategies, and literary analysis (themes, character development, writing style, literary devices, historical significance, etc.). This class is open to current sixth grade students who will be transitioning to seventh grade in the fall.

Seventh Grade Literature

Be a part of an interactive reading and writing workshop. Together we will breeze through the required summer reading and assignment. You will read and engage in dynamic discussions. Our text talks and writing will focus on the following: author's use of language and vocabulary, reading comprehension strategies such as predicting, visualizing, making connections, and inferring, and literary analysis of characters, setting, plot, elements, themes, and text construction. This class is open to current seventh grade students who will be transitioning to eighth grade in the fall.

Introduction to Kindergarten - Part II – Weekly Themes

This will be a continuation of Session 1, where we will further explore the weekly themes, both academically and developmentally! It would be my best recommendation that your incoming Kindergartener stay for both sessions, as we will be having lots of fun learning!

K-1 Transition Math and Discovery Science

This class will focus on math skills that are necessary for an easy transition to first grade! We will cover the different strategies for addition and subtraction, place value, fact families and much more. Students will also jump into the world of science and begin basic investigation and experimentation. This class is open to current kindergarten students who will be transitioning to first grade in the fall.

First Grade Math

Reinforce basic math concepts: place value, skip counting, time, and money. Through the use of games, manipulative materials, and everyday objects, math facts and double-digit addition and subtraction facts will be reviewed and reinforced. All these activities support critical thinking and problem solving skills. This class is open to current first grade students who will be transitioning to second grade in the fall.

Second Grade Math

Nail down those double and triple digit addition and subtraction problems. Review money, time, fractions, geometry, and regrouping. Build the foundational skills that

will prepare you for third grade math! This class is open to current second grade students who will be transitioning to third grade in the fall.

Third Grade Math

Keep those math skills sharp! This class will allow your children to continue to practice those skills that your child has worked so hard on this year: multiplication and division facts, problem solving, computation, and more! Summer math practice can be FUN and will help your children build the foundational skills that will prepare them for fourth grade math! We will be incorporating technology into the classes and iPads are required. This class is open to current third grade students who will be transitioning to fourth grade in the fall.

Fourth Grade Math

Strengthen fourth grade skills and prepare for fifth grade math. The class will not only involve drilling on basic facts for addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division, but will also include long division, fractions, and decimals! We will have fun with games and brainteasers. Problem solving activities will be used to explore critical thinking skills. Get a jump-start and preview fifth grade math! This class is open to current fourth grade students who will be transitioning to fifth grade in the fall.
